
CITY, PORTUGAL RAINHA

On the upper level a small bungalow with a cantilevered roof houses the kitchen and dining room, living room and fireplace, offering 360-degree views of the surrounding countryside. Outside the volume, behind the glass curtain façades, polished concrete floors extend to all four cardinal points, offering stunning views into the landscape. Downstairs, the bedrooms are arranged around a central space, take advantage of the absence of orthogonal angles to create a dynamic atmosphere. The volume is characterized by the subtle distribution of light, which contributes to a calm and sublime atmosphere.














left: Basement. right: Basement plan_Entrance to guestrooms_View into living room_Basement and staircase.
